- The courses like Machine Learning, Artificial Intelligence, Deep Learning with python, Neural Networks, Industry 4.0 can be introduced under Professional Elective category.
- Recent edition text books can be referred for all the courses.
- Revised Bloom Taxonomy has to be incorporated in Course Objectives.
- Credits allocated to Humanities and Science (HS) category can be reduced and the deducted credits can award to professional core (PC) courses.

**Item 2.1: Resolved** to confirm the minutes of the first board of studies meeting held on 27.06.2019


**Item 2.2: Resolved** to approve the curriculum for second year students admitted in the academic year 2019-20 under Regulation 2019.
