RESEARCH POLICY**PURPOSE**

To cultivate a dynamic and inclusive research culture that inspires faculty, students, and staff to explore emerging frontiers, generate impactful knowledge and develop innovative solutions that enrich institutional growth and contribute meaningfully to society.

OBJECTIVES

- To cultivate a strong culture of research and innovation across all departments of the institute.
- To establish dedicated research centres within each department of the institution.
- To support faculty members and researchers in effectively conducting their research activities.
- To motivate faculty and students to publish high quality research papers in reputed journals indexed in SCI, Scopus and Web of Science.
- To promote collaboration between internal members and other engineering institutions, industries and incubation units at both national and international levels.
- To encourage faculty members to develop and submit research proposals, thereby increasing research funding from various government, non-government, and industrial sources.
- To implement village-focused outreach initiatives based on research outcomes under programs such as AICTE's Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.

RESEARCH POLICY

The Research and Development (R&D) Cell of the college is functioning with the objective of supporting and developing the research community both within and around the campus. Currently, the institute provides official duty permissions and active encouragement to faculty members and students across departments to participate in various research oriented activities. These include seminars, workshops, Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Staff Development Programmes (SDPs), specialized training sessions and paper presentations at technical symposiums and conferences. All these are aimed at creating a vibrant research ecosystem.


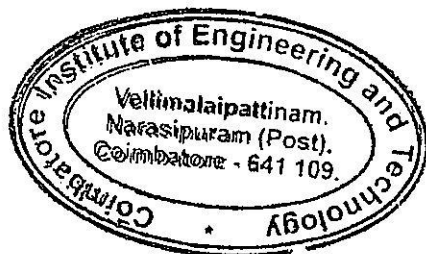
Faculty members and students from all departments are actively encouraged to publish their research in reputed, high-impact journals. The institution also motivates faculty to chase for research funding from national and international funding agencies. Looking ahead, the college plans to extend financial support across various stages of the research process to further strengthen its commitment. Additionally, consultancy services are being initiated to benefit communities in and around the institute. The well-equipped laboratories and comprehensive library facilities are consistently made accessible to the research fraternity both within the campus and from neighbouring institutions, establishing a collaborative and inclusive research environment. Incentive norms are being exercised to faculty members for all the activities related to the research.

To further elevate the research ecosystem, the institution is undertaking a comprehensive revision once in every academic year. The updated policy will introduce strategic measures to promote interdisciplinary collaboration, incentivize high-impact publications in SCI, Scopus and Web of Science indexed journals and streamline the process for patent filings and intellectual property protection.

It will also expand institutional support for securing national and international funding through agencies such as DST, AICTE, DRDO, and SERB, while encouraging faculty to engage in consultancy services and industry-linked projects. Structured guidelines for research ethics, data management and outcome dissemination will be embedded to ensure transparency and academic integrity. Additionally, the revised policy will include capacity-building initiatives such as grant-writing workshops, proposal review panels, and seed funding schemes to nurture early-stage research ideas. Through these concerted efforts, CIET reaffirms its commitment to becoming a hub of research excellence, innovation, and societal impact.

UPDATION OF POLICY

The Research Policy of the college is scheduled for revision in the academic year 2026–27, with a strategic focus on strengthening the culture of research and innovation across the institution. All research-related activities are systematically administered through the Research and Development Cell, in close coordination with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), ensuring coherence with institutional objectives and compliance with national standards.
