


























MINUTES OF THE SIXTH ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

Amendment in Regulation 2023

12.6 Assessment for Project Integrated Practical Project Integrated Practical is considered to be purely INTERNAL (with 100% internal marks only). Project work may be assigned to a single student or to a group of students not exceeding 4 in a group. There shall be three assessments (Two reviews and one project presentation) during the semester by a review committee. The student shall make a presentation on the progress made before the committee. There shall be a minimum of three members in the review committee. The project Guide will be one of the members of the Review Committee. The Head of the Department with the approval of the Head of the Institution shall appoint Internal Examiners. The Assessment marks for Project Integrated Practical will be distributed as indicated below.			12.6 Assessment for Project Integrated Practical Project Integrated Practical comprises of practical and project components. Every practical exercise / experiment shall be evaluated based on conduct of experiment / exercise and records to be maintained. The average of marks for each exercise/ experiment are to be converted to 30 marks. These practical exercises/experiments are fundamental in preparing students for their project work. The project work may be assigned to a single student or to a group of students not exceeding 4 in a group. The End Semester Examination for project work shall consist of evaluation of the final project report submitted by the student or students of the project group by an examiner followed by a viva-voce examination conducted separately for each student. The Head of the Department, with the approval of the Head of the Institution, will appoint the internal, external or both examiners. The marks for the Continuous Assessment and End Semester Examinations for the Project Work and the Viva-Voce Examination are distributed as indicated above.

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All the University nominees, academic and industrial experts have suggested the following

- Remedial Classes may be conducted for the students those who have arrear in end semester examinations to improve the pass percentage especially for analytical subjects.
- Collaborations with premier institutions in India and abroad should be initiated to enhance collaborative research activities.
- A committee may be formed in a department level to review the NPTEL Courses registered by the students in a semester and necessary steps may be taken to transfer the credits as per R2023 regulation.
- Research publications should be enhanced in the upcoming academic year by increasing the number of research supervisors and research departments.

It is resolved to take necessary actions related to the valuable suggestions offered by the members.
